Fear of a large scale Native American invasion was kept alive by the never ending stream of minor attacks. Small bands of six to twelve men moved in and out of Kentucky attacking small groups of settlers, stealing horses and provisions.

March:

Clear's Station a small band of Natives attacked Colonel Floyd and his brother above the crossing of the Wilderness Trail. John Floyd was killed.

October:

Richland's Creek a family of settlers was defeated by Native Americans.
