

1785 and 1786

1785:

Exact Dates Unknown- The Cherokee finally get into the fight. They send several raids into Kentucky in 1785.

1786:

Spring- Band of 70 Chickamauga Cherokee move north of the Ohio River, from which they raided Kentucky settlements.

Fall- Kentucky sends an invasion against the tribes north of the Ohio river. The invasion was led by George Rogers Clark. Clark left with 1000 men, 300 of them deserted before they ever reached the Native Americans. At the same time Logan took 50 men against the Shawnee. Clark's expedition was a failure, but Logan's burned Shawnee towns, killed warriors and was a great success.
