

1787

February:

Kentucky called out the militia to protect Limestone and the frontier of Fayette County from roaming bands of Native Americans.

March:

Captain John Logan raised a company of 130 men and led them into Tennessee on the trail of a band of Cherokee. He had intended to attack the Cherokee town, Crow Town. They lost their way and ran into a group of Chickamuaga Cherokee and a fight commenced in which seven Cherokee were killed. After which Logan returned home. The Cherokee formed a party of forty to seek retribution against the settlers, but they were persuaded against the invasion by an Indian trader.

Exact date unknown:

George Gibson was killed in his field, on North Elkhorn Creek, by Native Americans.
